Dear Parents,

This is a follow-up to my letter of 12 October 2009 in reference to the water quality at Hainerberg ES and Wiesbaden MS.

The U.S. Army Center for Health Promotion and Preventive Medicine (USACHPPMEUR) has evaluated the water samples taken on 9 October 2009. Their tests indicate all samples were below U.S. Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) action levels for Legionella bacteria and therefore not a health hazard.

We will increase the frequency of re-testing the water samples at these schools and flush the systems after major school holiday periods such as Winter and Spring Breaks.

Our school facility maintenance manager and maintenance contractor will continue to work with the USAG Wiesbaden DPW and Preventive Health officials to assure the safety of our students.

Once again, there is no health risk to your children. We will continue to keep you informed as new information becomes available.
